Regulations

on the 2nd International Clarinet and Saxophone Contest «Sunny Clarinets» within the framework of

the International Instrumental Music Festival «Sunny Clarinets»

April 1- May 7, 2021

1. Aim

The aim of the 2nd International Clarinet and Saxophone Contest «Sunny Clarinets» (hereinafter referred to as the Contest) is to develop the prestige of artistic education, to identify and support young talented musicians, to increase their technical and artistic performing skills, to popularize the best examples of Ukrainian and world music art, to gain experience of young musicians in contests. The contest contributes to the cultural relations amplifying and the experience exchanging between leading cultural and artistic centres of Ukraine, music institutions and educational institutions of culture and arts, the expansion of international relations, further development of musical art in Ukraine and abroad, increases the level of qualification training of future musicians.

2. Participants

Clarinet and saxophone performers, art school, specialized art boarding school students and educational institution students under the age of 20 from Ukraine and abroad are invited to participate in the Contest.

Participants are divided into three age groups:

1st group - **junior** under 12 years old;

2nd group - **middle** from 12 to 16 years old;

3 ^d group - **senior** from 16 to 20 years old.

Age of contestants is taken into account till March 31st, 2021.

3. Conditions and Procedure

- 3.1. The Contest will be held for two stages for all the groups:
 1st round April 1-10, 2021 (online);
 2nd round May 4-7, 2021 (offline).
- 3.2. Contestant's performance can be filmed by any available gadgets (either professional or non-pro camera) in Full HD video 1920x1080 up to 25 or 50fps (frames per second). Video recording can't be done before the public call for applications (December 1, 2020).
- 3.3. Programme video recording should be made by fixed camera (on a tripod) wide shot in a natural acoustic hall or room without any editing.
- 3.4. Video recorded contestant's performance is required to be downloaded on cloud storage Fex.net, link and application form should be sent before March 31, 2021 to e-mail: sunny.clarinets@gmail.com.
- 3.5. Contestant's personal information (i.e. name, surname, age, educational institution and programme) is forbidden to be publicized by above mentioned video.
- 3.6. 1st round contestant order is defined by the received application date through assigned ordinal number.
- 3.7. Contestant's performance is assessed by the jury during April 1-10, 2021.
- 3.8. 1st round results will be published on the Contest page in Facebook on April 11, 2021.
- 3.9. All the Contest expenses will be born by participants.
- 3.10. The winners will be announced and the prize will be awarded in the final concert.

4. Contest Requirements

1st group **junior**

two various - charactered small form pieces of music at the participant's choice

two various - charactered pieces of music at the participant's choice

3^d group **senior**

- > 1st or 2nd and 3^d parts of large form pieces of music;
- > two various charactered small form pieces of music at the participant's choice.

Contestant's performance duration

1st group **junior**

The total performing time for each contestant is up to 10 minutes.

2nd group **middle**

The total performing time for each contestant is up to 15 minutes.

3^d group **senior**

The total performing time for each contestant is up to 15 minutes.

The order of performing pieces of music is at the participant's choice.

The performing of the Contest program by heart in both rounds is obligatory.

5. Assessment criteria

According to the following criteria, such as:

- ✓ technique,
- artistry,
- ✓ skill

assessment is carried out.

6. Jury

- 6.1. The jury is formed from Ukrainian and world famous cultural and art figures by the Contest organizators. The head of the jury is elected by the organisation committee.
- 6.2. The jury has the right:
 - to recommend the contestants;
 - to set special awards and prizes for the performers;
 - ▶ to have not all places and prizes awarded and to divide prizes between the contestants according to the peculiarities of educational institution the contestant studies:
 - ▶ to award grand prix.
- 6.3. The jury has the right to stop the performance.
- 6.4. The jury's decision is final and not subject to further appeal.

7. Contest Awards

7.1. The jury decide the winners in every group according to the instrument and the title of the 1st, 2nd, 3^d laureate or the title of the diploma recipient is awarded.

Sponsoring organizations have the right to set special prizes and awards for the contestants on advice of the jury.

8. Contestant Application

8.1. The applicant should send to e-mail: sunny.clarinets@gmail.com.

before March 31, 2021 the following:

- \checkmark application form for the Contest;
- ✓ filmed contestant's performance in Full HD video 1920x1080 up to 25 or 50fps;
- ✓ registration fee receipt copy (electronic copy);
- ✓ birth certificate, ID or passport copy and identification code copy;
- \checkmark the contestant's photo (6 x 4cm).
- 8.2. After paying the registration fee and submitting all the above mentioned documents before March 31, 2021the contestant's participation will be

confirmed through assigned ordinal number by the organizers. If the participant refuses to contest, a registration fee will not be returned.

9. Financial conditions

The Contest is non-commercial. According to the current legislation of Ukraine the organisation committee forms its funds due to the contestant's registration fee, sponsorship or charitable funds.

The contestant's registration fee is 350 UAH (10 \in).

Payment details will be specified up to March 10, 2021.
